### Dashed Pedestrian Crossing Lines

The two solid white lines found on pedestrian crossings at traffic junctions will be replaced by dashes. This is to help motorists differentiate between stop line (denoted by solid line) and pedestrian crossing lines (denoted by dashes).

### Pedestrian Crossing Ahead Markings

Inverted white triangular signs on the road before selected zebra crossings serve to give motorists ample notice to stop.

### Traffic Calming Markings

A series of white triangular markings on the road to create a visually narrower lane that encourages motorists to slow down.

### 齿形减速标志

### Your Speed Sign

An electronic sign that displays the speed of a passing vehicle enables the motorist to be more aware of his travelling speed and consequently encourages him to keep to the speed limit.
